The English as a Second Language Department seeks to provide educational opportunities specific to the needs of English Learners such that students may succeed academically in the following content areas: Social & Instructional, Language, Math, Science, and Social Studies, while meeting Title III & OCR compliance measures.

State & Title III Compliance Responsibilities

- Identify, assess, and place students who are from non-English language backgrounds.
- Identify immigrant students and assist in their assimilation to the United States
- Provide a rigorous language instruction program that increases English language proficiency and student achievement.
- Provide instructional support and professional growth opportunities to ESL teachers in order to facilitate effective teaching and curriculum implementation.
- Provide instructional equipment, classroom supplies, and materials for effective language acquisition programs and academic development.
- Provide communication support for new immigrant parents and coordinate community outreach activities and translation services for the district.
- Manage the program budget, teacher assignments, and state and federal compliance obligations.
- Coordinate with SCS departments and schools to provide a high-quality language program that exceeds State and federal education department standards.
- Advise SCS departments and schools of state and federal education department compliance requirements.
- Collect and maintain district ELL data as required by State and Federal regulations.

Policy Citations

This program is mandated by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, SCS Board Policy 5016, Rules, Regulations, and Minimum Standards for the Governance of Tennessee Public Schools [Rule 0520-1-3-.056.a.1 and 2 ii], and Title III of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 2001 and <u>amendments made in 2015 via the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).</u>

Procedures for the Identification and Placement of English Language Learners

Primary Home Language Survey- The parents of all students new to Shelby County Schools should complete a primary home language survey at registration. There are 3 questions about the student's home language. If one or more responses are other than English, the student is classified as NELB *and assessed* for English language proficiency.


WIDA Screener (formerly W-APT, WIDA-ACCESS Placement Test) - The results of this assessment determine if an NELB student is proficient or limited English proficient and classified as an English Learner (EL) or fluent at entry (FEP).

Parent Notification Letter- Parents are to be notified within the first 30 days of enrollment of the status of their NELB student: EL, Exited, Transitional, or Consultation. This letter also informs parents of the instructional model and what assessment was used to designate students as ELL or FEP.

Parent Response Letter-This letter asks the parents to acknowledge receipt of the notification by agreeing or disagreeing with the ESL teacher's recommendation for placement of the student.

Transitional Monitoring Form-The academic progress of students who have exited the ESL program is followed for 2 years. This form is completed after quarters 1, 2, & 3 to document monitoring and assure the continued success of students in the mainstream classroom.

Procedures for the Identification and Placement of English Language Learners




Compliance Requirements


- TN State Board of Education Policy 3.207 establishes minimum required compliance requirements for LEAs serving students who are identified as English Learners (EL). Approved **service delivery models** are listed within this policy.
- Each year, the district is required to **document contact time** with ELLs at beginning English and intermediate proficiency levels, and then report this to the TN State Department of Education. Teacher schedules are to reflect that each EL whose score is below a 3.5 is scheduled for one hour of *daily* ESL service.

ESL Scheduling


- ELL students at beginning and intermediate levels of English proficiency must have a minimum of **one** hour per day of **direct services** provided by a highly qualified ESL teacher. For beginning-level elementary students (WIDA 1.0-3.4 in Overall), the pull-out model is often used as it provides a learning environment without distractions. This approach also allows for children from several classrooms to be served during a given instructional hour, thereby providing services that best support language acquisition. Should students at beginning WIDA levels be served in a co-teaching environment, it is advised that should these be RAELs, they are also served with an additional hour of English Language Development (ELD) within the RTI timeframe. Certainly, parallel literacy blocks (tier 1 instruction) conducted by certified ESL teachers is another option.
- Students at higher levels of English proficiency (WIDA 3.5 & above) may have more flexible scheduling that is tailored to meet their English language development needs. Inclusion/Collaborative teaching approaches (only) are more effective with ELs at high intermediate and advanced levels of proficiency and should include joint planning time for the collaborating teachers.
- ESL course codes are available for middle and high school ESL classes and provide English instruction especially designed for speakers of other languages as outlined in Minimum Requirements for the Approval of Public Schools 0520-01-03-.05, (6) (a). Some of the course codes can be used for grade level groupings while others are for proficiency level groupings. Secondary EL students at beginning and intermediate levels of proficiency must have a minimum of one ESL class period per day.
- Note: Scheduling of English as a Second Language classes during <u>RTI or during exploratory time (library, art, music, P.E.)</u> has the unintended effect of denying EL students access to exploratory subjects that are available to all other students.
- ELL students in high school may use up to 2 ESL courses toward fulfillment of the English graduation requirement of 4 units. Recommended progression includes 2 ESL courses, then enrollment in English I, followed by English II. More advanced students may elect to enroll in English III & IV, after completion of English I. ESL courses beyond those used toward the English graduation requirements can be used as part of an elective focus in the Humanities area.



Our district strives to provide a supportive environment that encourages a culture of teaching and learning so that each one of our students attains academic excellence. Daily Life

School

Daily attendance is essential for learning. All children living in the state of Tennessee between the ages of 6 and 17 **are required by state law to attend school**. They are eligible for free public schooling regardless of their immigration status or the immigration status of their parents. We encourage you to participate in your children's school and let their teachers know that you are interested in their education.

All new students to Shelby County Schools, **entering grades K-12** must contact his/her zoned school to begin the registration process. You can find your assigned school online at: <u>http://scstransquery.scsk12.org/eduweb/webquery</u>

You will also need to create a Parent PowerSchool account once your child has been put into the system to complete registration. You will need an active email address to do so. You can get an email address on free sites like Gmail, Yahoo or Hotmail.
