MINIMUM TRAINING AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree
- Tennessee Teaching License with an instrumental music endorsement
- Highly Qualified as required by NCLB
- Minimum of three years of successful experience as a Strings teacher preferred
- Such alternatives as the Superintendent may find appropriate and acceptable

REPORTS TO: Director of Middle and Secondary Education

JOB GOAL: To assist in the development and implementation of an instrumental music program with a concentration on string instruments that will provide the best possible instructional experience for each student.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides music instruction to students using standard and teacher-prepared instructional materials.
- Develops instructional plans and organizes class time to provide a balanced program of instruction, demonstration and performance time.
- Meets with principals and other music teachers to discuss the implementation of curriculum goals.
- Participates in appropriate staff development activities.
- Completes all required records and reports, including student progress reports.
- Uses oral and written communication skills effectively.
- Performs such other duties as assigned by the principal or the Director of Middle and Secondary Education.
