- *Parents should confirm enrollment with special education secretary at child's school prior to first day of school.*

REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

✓ Two (2) Forms of Proof of Residence:

Only the following forms of proof will be accepted: *Sale Contract* (no contingency agreements); *Real Estate Tax Receipt*; *Mortgage Information*; *Current MLGW Bill*, *Turn-On Receipt* or *Municipal Water Bill*; *Lease/Rental Contract* (Naval personnel living on the base need only a housing letter.).

✓ New Immunization Requirements:

K-12 students must have a TN School Immunization Certificate showing: *Two (2) doses of MMR*, *Two (2) doses of Varicella* or *proof of Chickenpox*, *Four (4) doses of Polio* and *Four (4) doses of DTP-Hib-Td* (all students); *Two (2) doses of Hepatitis A* (Grade K); *Tdap* (Grade 7); *Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B* (Grades K & 7). KINDERGARTEN & TRANSFER STUDENTS

✓ Kindergarten:

Students must be 5 years-old on or before September 30, 2010 and provide: *Certified Copy of Child's Birth Certificate*; *TN Child Health Record* or *Temporary Certificate of Immunization* (proof of physical exam within one year prior to enrollment); and *Student's Social Security Card* (T.C.A. 49-6-5102).

✓ In-State Public School Transfer:

Students entering Shelby County Schools from another Tennessee public school system may enroll, but must submit academic and health records as soon as possible.

✓ Out-of-State/Non-Public School Transfer:

Students entering Shelby County Schools from another state or a non-public school must provide: *Permanent TN Child Health Record* or a *current Temporary Health Certificate* (including physical exam).
