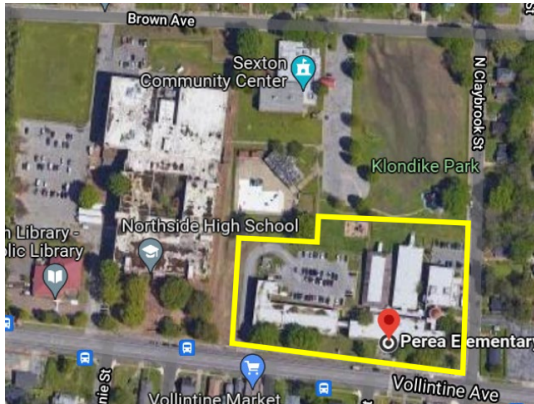

SHRINE MURAL DONATION

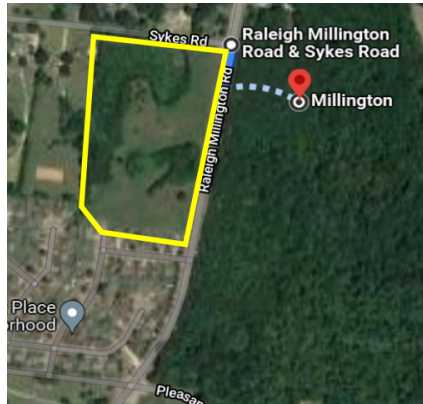

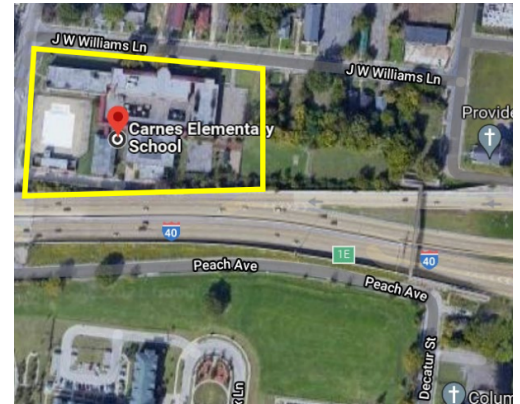
