During the October committee meeting, the Board met to discuss donations for the Shrine school, several real estate updates, and survey results on the performance of custodial vendors.

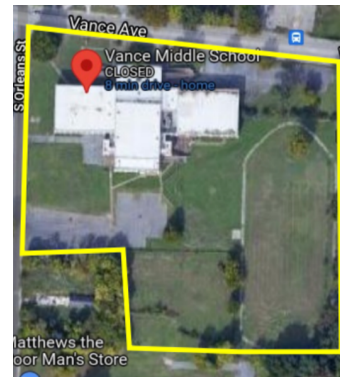

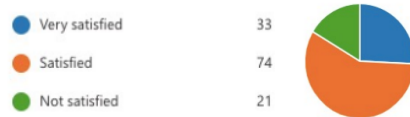
