## Creating an Intervention

### What is an Intervention?

An intervention is a service that assists a student in overcoming the issues they are having or dealing with. You can create interventions and intervention plans within the platform for each specific student or by groups of students at a time, depending upon how your school wants to implement the platform. Steps to create an intervention for a student are below.

### Where to go?

You may access the concern section by

- 1) logging into Clarity
- 2) selecting a student
- 3) clicking on the **Interventions** tab (see below)
