Beginning Sounds: The /t/ sound is a voiceless or unvoiced sound because the vocal cords do not vibrate when you make the sound. Instead, we use a puff of air to make the sound.

Short a, Long a: Whether a vowel has a long sound, short sound, or remains silent, depends on its position in a word and the letters around it.

Onset and Rime Blending and Segmentation: The "**onset**" is the initial phonological unit of any word (e.g. c in cat) and the term "**rime**" refers to the string of letters that follow, usually a vowel and final consonants (e.g. at in cat). **Blending** involves pulling together individual sounds or syllables within words; **segmenting** involves breaking words down into individual sounds or syllables.

Beginning Sound: The /k/ sound is the hard sound of the letter c. When c meets a, o, u, or another consonant it produces the hard sound. C is a voiceless consonant. **Read with Expression:** Expression refers to the ability to change your voice to show feeling when reading. When reading aloud, fluent readers read in phrases and add intonation appropriately. Their reading is smooth and has expression.
