

OVERVIEW

- 2,000 students
- Current program is 388,620 SF
 - reduced from 430,000 SF
 - 194 SF/student
 - 328,450 Main Building
 - 60,170 Fieldhouse


National Comparison





- CCTE, Fine Arts, and Kitchen organized around shared loading & service court












SCHEMATIC 3D SPACE DIAGRAM


