MEMPHIS VIRTUAL SCHOOL

A Shelby County Schools
General Choice Transfer Option

As we did prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, **the District will offer the option of Memphis Virtual School (MVS) as part of school choice.** Unlike the LIVE synchronous instruction implemented during the 2020-21 school year, **the MVS model is centered around asynchronous learning (independent study) for grades 4 - 12. MVS is not currently an option for students in grades K - 3.**

MEMPHIS VIRTUAL SCHOOL

- ✓ Fully accredited online school serving students grades 4-12.
- ✓ Operates as an **Asynchronous model** (independent study) with support by certified teachers who offer tutoring/support during office hours.
- ✓ Offers a variety of electives, Honors, Advanced Placement (AP), and College, Career, & Technical Education (CCTE) in addition to core subjects.
- ✓ Attendance and participation on the platform are monitored.
- ✓ Grades 4-12 are eligible to enroll in MVS (including transfers from charter and contract schools).
- ✓ Enrolled students are able to participate in athletics and other extracurricular activities in their zone home school.

Previously Offered LIVE VIRTUAL LEARNING MODEL

- ✓ District-wide service implemented for all students during the 2020-21 school year.
- ✓ Operated as a **Synchronous model** (live study) as support came from assigned classroom teachers for students across the District.
- ✓ Classes offered were in alignment with the school the student was enrolled in during the duration of the live learning model.
- ✓ Attendance and participation were monitored by the classroom teachers.
- ✓ Grades K-12 were a part of the live learning model as digital devices were provided by the District for virtual learning.
- ✓ Student sports and extracurricular activities aligned with District, state, and CDC protocols.
