PROPOSED PRIORITIES & INVESTMENTS

MSCS has developed a proposed budget for the 2023-24 school year. Funds have been allocated to prioritize increased compensation for teachers, advanced academic opportunities, and safety. The District is also requesting Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) funds from the Shelby County Commission for deferred maintenance, school safety, building upgrades, and a new school in Frayser. Many of this year's budget priorities are a direct result of input from teachers, students, parents, and the greater community.
