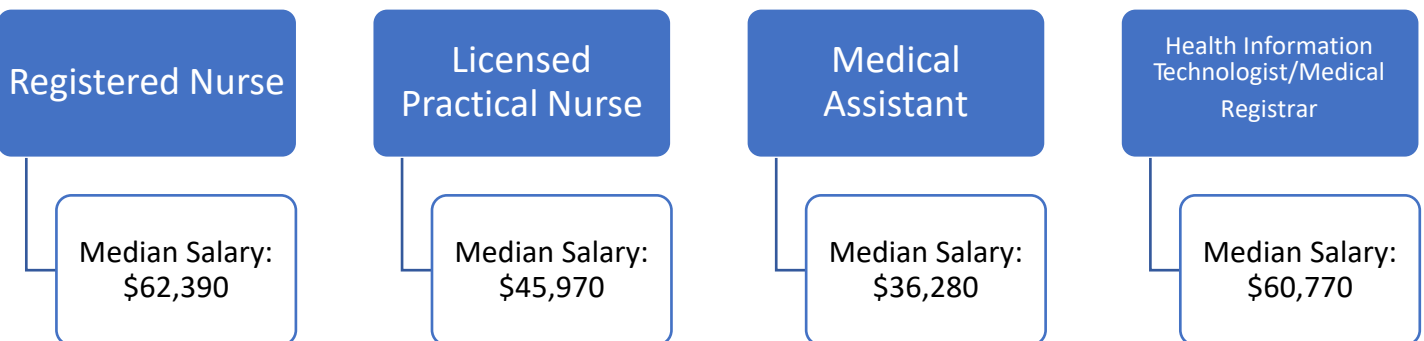
JOB OUTLOOK

The Therapeutic Nursing occupation group will have positive growth statewide between 2014 and 2022. Employment of registered nurses is projected to grow 14-16 percent from 2014 to 2024, much faster than the average for all occupations. Growth will occur for a number of reasons, including an increased emphasis on preventive care; growing rates of chronic conditions, such as diabetes and obesity; and demand for healthcare services from the baby-boom population, as they live longer and more active lives.



OCCUPATION PROFILE

The most rapidly growing industry is the healthcare support services including billing clerks, medical records and health information technicians, medical assistants, and medical secretaries designed to assist the medical fields in various relevant areas of healthcare.

PROGRAM OF STUDY PROFILE

Therapeutic Nursing Services is designed to prepare students to pursue careers in the field of nursing. Upon completion of this program, a proficient student will be able to implement communication and interpersonal skills, maintain residents' rights and independence, provide care safely, prevent emergency situations, prevent infection through infection control, and perform the skills required of a nursing assistant. Students will log forty hours of site-based clinical work with at least 24 of those hours spent in a long-term care facility as part of the Level 4 course.
