

# Key Performance Indicators: K-2 SEAs

- 83% of SEAs provide instructional support when the classroom teacher is teaching (up 52% from Q2).
- 37% reported <u>only</u> providing instructional support during this time (up 21% from Q2).
- SEAs are still asked to perform noninstructional tasks while their classroom teacher is teaching such as:
  - Substituting (53%)
  - Non-instructional academic supports (47%)
  - Monitoring the lunchroom (47%)






### Key Performance Indicators: K-2 SEAs

- 66% of teachers reported that their SEA provides whole-group instruction daily and 61% daily small group support.
- 89% of teachers indicate that their SEA's support is valuable (2 points higher than Q2).
- Compared to Q1 & Q2 teachers reported that SEAs are working with the students more frequently on academic tasks.

In what ways does the SEA support the students' achievement in your class (check all that apply)?




■Q1 ■Q2 ■Q3



### Key Performance Indicators: K-2 SEAs


- Principals, teachers, and SEAs completed the Q3 survey in March.
- Response Rates:
  - Principals- 97%
  - Teacher- 33%
  - SEAs- 54%
- 66% of principals have reported SEA turnover (up from 44% in Q2) and 75% of those indicated the SEA got a better job, many moved into teaching roles.





# **Key Performance Indicators: Tutoring**

- **7,981 students are actively enrolled** in tutoring and tracked in PowerSchool.
- The average attendance rate is:
  - Before-school- 86%
  - After-school- 91%
- The most common type of tutoring remains ELA.
- Elementary, **specifically 2<sup>nd</sup> grade**, has the most tutored students.
- Middle school students have the lowest attendance, though still high for extracurricular programs (84%–89%).





# **Key Performance Indicators: Tutoring**

#### ELA (K-8)

- **4,108 K–8 students** are receiving tutoring in ELA & have i-Ready metrics.
- 66.1% of tutored students\* are on track to meet or have **met the 5% growth goal**.

#### <u>Math (K–8)</u>

- 2,481 K-8 students are receiving tutoring in math & have i-Ready metrics.
- 60.6% of tutored students\* are on track to meet or have **met the 5% growth goal**.

\* Attended at least 15 sessions with an attendance rate above 30%.
