7. Disease Management/ Medical Needs



MORE INFORMATION TO CONSIDER

Monitors are not be expected to be the instructor for the students, but their role will be essential in helping students to maximize their learning experience each day. Monitors will:

- Assist students with logging in on time according to their instructional schedule that will be provided by the school.
- Ensure that students login on time.
- Make sure students are staying on task during class time.
- Assist students with troubleshooting with technology issues if they arise.
- Assist students with interacting with the teacher virtually in the Microsoft Teams platform.
- Make sure students are following the virtual classroom rules and protocols established by the teacher (e.g., cameras on, microphones on mute).
- Assist students with independent work assignments. There will be times when students won't be engaging with the teachers but will instead have independent work assignments to be completed on the computer or in student workbooks/paper pencil.

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
