Project Graduation is a grade recovery program which allows SCS students to retake failed classes to recover credit and satisfy graduation requirements. Project Graduation also serves as an accelerated graduation program for students interested in taking new coursework to satisfy graduation requirements in order to graduate early. Most students are aware there is an opportunity to recover failing grades through the Project Graduation afternoon/evening program made available to students in the Spring of each school-year. The administration would like for the parent/guardian of each student to understand White Station High School teachers will only recommend students for the Project Graduation program who demonstrate satisfactory effort in their class(es). In other words, students will not be allowed to sit in a class here all semester not making an effort to do any of the work and go to Project Graduation.

White Station High School's administration has already received the support of the district to withhold this opportunity from those students who decide, before making an attempt in class(es), they are going to recover credit(s) for the class(es) in Project graduation. Therefore, we ask our Spartan parents/guardians to encourage their student(s) to do their best in class(es), in order to show sincere effort to learn content and complete course assignments, as teachers will only recommend students who do so for the 2018-2019 Project Graduation program.
