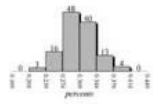

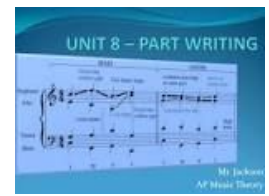
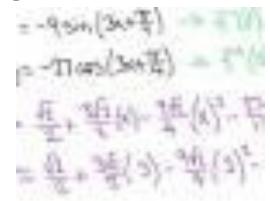


Frequency of Serve Completion Average

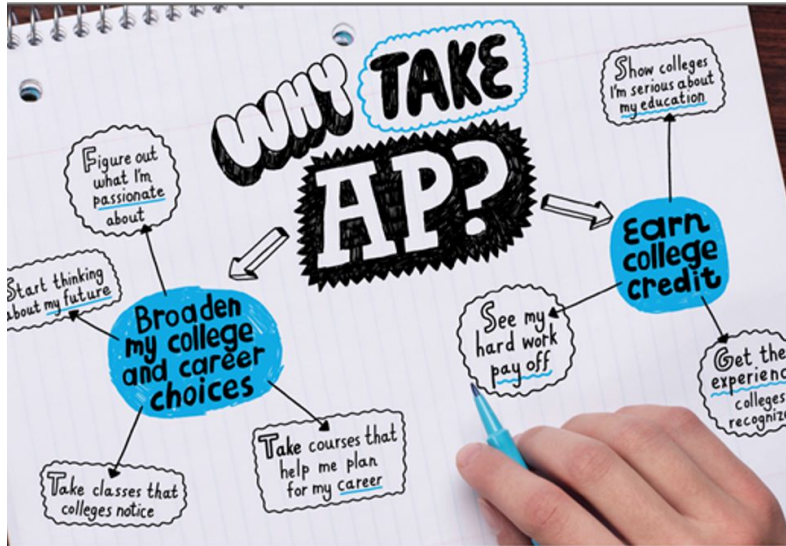


Overview of Courses

- Don't take classes just to take them

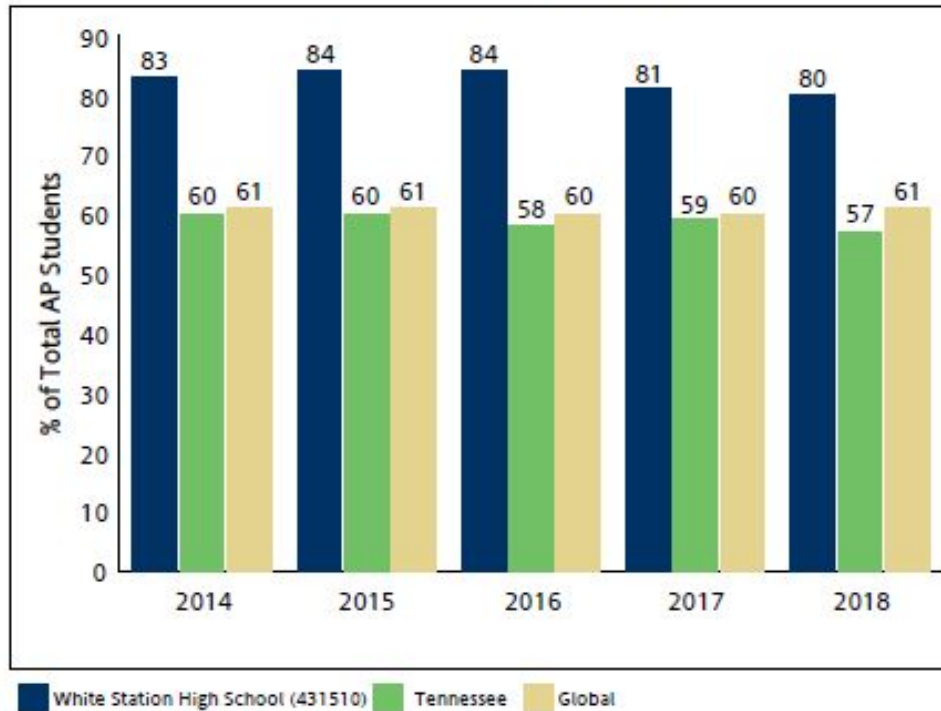

Things to Consider

1. Cost by exam (\$94 - AP Seminar and Research are \$142)
2. **NEW DEADLINE:** Fees are now due October 1st
3. We cannot order an exam for you if you have not paid.
4. You and your parents must sign a contract.
5. You cannot simply drop an AP course at any time.
6. **No AP Exam = No AP Credit**
7. Apply for anything you “might” want to take
8. Be flexible. Sometimes classes overlap (scheduling).

Application closes March 8th at 3:30 pm. Results by March 19th via email. Appeals March 20-21.
