Participation Agreement**

Participating in athletics and/or extra curricular activities at Millington Central High School is an honor and privilege. When a student puts on his/her uniform he/she represents all of the students at Millington Central High School as well as the entire community. Students who participate in athletics and extra curricular activities are leaders and role models and must conduct themselves as such. It is the responsibility of the parents, coaches, sponsors, and school administrators to ensure that our students who participate in athletics and extra curricular activities always conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the highest level of sportsmanship, character, and honor. To this end the following code of conduct will apply to every student participating in a sport and/or extra curricular activity at Millington Central High School.

I will conduct myself such that my parents, school, and community are proud to have me represent them on the field of competition. I will strive to be an example for other students at Millington Central High School both on and off the field. I will set the highest level of sportsmanship possible at all times.

I understand that, should I conduct myself inappropriately during an athletic contest and/or extra curricular activity, I will be disciplined for my behavior. This disciplinary action may include In School Suspension, Out of School Suspension, and removal from the team or organization. (The same standards and expectations for school will be applied to behavior at said events).

Shelby County School Board Policy #6505 states, "Organizations (non-school) Sororities, Fraternities and other secret organizations shall not be operated in the Shelby County Schools. No organization shall be allowed that is not open for membership to the entire student body."

Millington Central High School's official position is that anyone found to be involved in any organization, group, club, etc. that is in direct violation of the above policy can forfeit the right to represent Millington Central High School in any sport and/or extra-curricular activities.

It is the responsibility of players and parents to provide medical/health insurance during athletic participation.

***ATHLETIC ACTIVITY FEE***

***A \$75 yearly athletic activity fee is assessed per student per TSSAA sport(s) each year. This \$75 fee per year for a student will cover all sports they are in. The fee must be paid to the HEAD COACH of the sport prior to the first day of competition (cash, cashiers check, or money order only). The fee is not assessed for tryouts. The fee is nonrefundable.***
