



SAFETY WHEN ARRIVING AND LEAVING CAMPUS

- Secure your valuables inside the trunk of your vehicle out of plain view.
- Be aware of your surroundings when arriving or leaving campus. Don't be distracted by talking or texting on the phone.
- Look inside and under your car before entering.
- When entering your vehicle, immediately lock your doors and keep it locked even while driving.
- Have keys in hand when leaving and be prepared to use them if needed (alarm/panic button) and ready to open the car door immediately.
- Try to leave campus in pairs or as a group.
- Avoid carrying large amounts of cash - use check or credit card.
- When staying late, park in a highly visible well-lighted space.
- Report immediately any suspicious person(s) or activity on campus and remain inside the school until help arrives.
- Don't overburden yourself with packages. This will deter pickpockets and/or purse snatching.

Note: You can contact SCS Security prior to leaving campus late at night, if an escort is needed to walk you to your vehicle. **Remember, emergency calls are priority** and we suggest you call thirty (30) minutes prior to leaving campus to reduce your wait time.
