Who:

Seniors and juniors from all MSCS high schools are encouraged to apply. Interns will be randomly selected via lottery from the application pool.



What:

MSCS departments and partners will provide students the opportunity to engage in internship opportunities. Such opportunities will enhance students in the areas of skill development, personal development, and career exploration toward post-secondary success.



Why:

The internship program is designed to strengthen post-secondary readiness for MSCS students by providing first-hand career exposure and relationships with industry experts.

Participating interns will receive a stipend and also complete soft-skills training.



When:

The District is providing students with two options annually for internship exposure. It is our hope that your organization will engage with the program by providing internship opportunities for either or both options:

Spring Internship: January - April
Summer Internship: June - July

Interns will be expected to report in-person to their worksite for a minimum of 5 hours and a maximum of 10 hours per week.
