## Bus Safeły-Proper Loading and Unloading




## Loading Procedures

- Students should get to bus stop at least five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive and wait in a designated location for the school bus, facing the bus as it approaches.
- When the bus approaches, stand at least three giant steps (6 feet) away from the curb, and line up away from the street.
- Wait until the bus stops, the door opens, and the driver says that it's okay before stepping onto the bus.
- If you must cross the street in front of the bus, walk on the sidewalk or along the side of the road to a point at least five giant steps ( 10 feet) ahead of the bus before you cross. Be sure that the bus driver can see you, and you can see the bus driver.
- Students should board the school bus slowly, in single file, and use the handrail. The dome light should be on while loading in the dark.
- Never walk behind the bus.
- Walk at least three giant steps away from the side of the bus.
- If you drop something near the bus, tell the bus driver. Never try to pick it up because the driver may not be able to see you.
