


Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).


The ACT consists of curriculum-based tests of education development in English, mathematics, reading and science designed to measure the skills needed for success in first-year college coursework. The district's ACT composite for 2016 was 16.8. Students are not considered college ready until they have ACT scores of 22 or higher. The chart below shows the ACT composite score for <u>City University School of Liberal Arts</u> along with a regional and district composite scores. The Graduation Rate listed below is the actual graduation rate for the class of 2016. It is calculated by dividing the number of on-time general education graduates by the total number of students in the graduation cohort.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.






Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.






Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.






Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.






Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) 2015-16.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).






Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).






Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).






Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.


Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).








Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.


Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).








Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.


Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).








Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.


Figure 4. 2015-16 student suspensions (percent of enrolled students suspended).



College and Career Readiness


The ACT consists of curriculum-based tests of education development in English, mathematics, reading and science designed to measure the skills needed for success in first-year college coursework. The district's ACT composite for 2016 was 16.8. Students are not considered college ready until they have ACT scores of 22 or higher. The chart below shows the ACT composite score for The Soulsville Charter School along with a regional and district composite scores. The Graduation Rate listed below is the actual graduation rate for the class of 2016. It is calculated by dividing the number of on-time general education graduates by the total number of students in the graduation cohort.





Exam Success Rate

The state of TN administered a new, more rigorous assessment for the first time during the 2015-16 school year. Schools across the state performed much lower than on the previous state assessment. Problems with the administration of the online exam resulted in a cancellation of the assessment for grades 3-8. The Exam Success Rate included in this report is the total number of students in grades 9-12 in the "On Track" or "Mastered" in all tested subject areas divided by the total number of valid exams for students in grades 9-12. The Exam Success Rate is another measure of how students are performing academically.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.




Figure 1. Fall enrollment (day 40) from 2012-13 to 2016-17.
