



## Ed-Fi Dashboard Use Cases

### Assistant Principal

**Title:** Using Discipline Data to Inform Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) Team Meetings

**Role:** Jackson Anderson, Assistant Principal at Shabazz Middle School

**Background:** Mr. Anderson is on the PBIS team at his school and has an upcoming meeting to discuss recent discipline incidents. This team monitors discipline issues on a 20-day cycle. Areas of concern for this team include school code of conduct violations and state reportable actions. Through review of these data, the team can make data-driven decisions around PBIS plans.

**Usage Scenario:**

- Mr. Anderson logs in to the Ed-Fi Academic Dashboard and lands on Shabazz Middle School's page.
- He navigates to the **Attendance and Discipline sub-tab** and scrolls down to the **Discipline** section.
- Mr. Anderson clicks on the **"More" button**, selects **"Student List"** and is shown a student grid with discipline infractions.
- He first **sorts the State Reportable Actions** to identify the top 5 students with the most infractions in this category.
- He then **sorts the Local Incidents** column to identify the top 5 students with the most infractions in this category.
- He compiles the list of the 10 students and is ready to discuss behavior interventions for these children during the PBIS meeting.

*Note: Mr. Anderson could also export the Student List and complete the sorting exercise in Excel to bring to the meeting.*
