MSCS HAS APPROPRIATED ~\$158 MILLION IN ESSER 2.0 AND ESSER 3.0 FUNDING FOR BUILDING UPGRADES.



The District pursued deferred maintenance projects at MSCS-owned buildings, including the following:

- Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units
- Water quality/access improvement
- To promote social distancing, the District has pursued **ESSER-funded building construction**, including the following projects:
 - Brownsville Road Elementary
 - Geeter K-8
 - Macon Hall Elementary
 - Melrose High

- Mt. Pisgah Middle
- Sheffield Elementary
- Westhaven Elementary
- Willow Oaks Elementary

WITH THE COMPLETION OF THESE PROJECTS, DEFERRED MAINTENANCE COULD POTENTIALLY BE REDUCED FROM THE ORIGINAL \$476.5 MILLION TO \$280 MILLION BY FISCAL YEAR 2025.
