The intent is to keep students or unauthorized personnel from entering the demolition area. Install gates as necessary to accommodate any egress requirements. After demolition completion the fence shall be removed from the site.

Various Portable Classroom Demolitions Additional Requirements:

- Regarding the fluorescent light tubes that are present in the portable classrooms. During demolition and removal of portables, the contractor will be required to follow safe handling and disposal procedures per local, state, and federal regulations.
- MSCS may salvage the refrigerant in the HVAC units prior to demolition. Those units if any will be identified and labeled accordingly by MSCS. Any refrigerant remaining in an HVAC unit prior to demolition will be the responsibility of the Contractor to properly evacuate and recover. The refrigerant reclamation process must be performed by an EPA certified technician per all Codes having jurisdiction.
