

## Questions and Answers IFB # 05012023MT - Forward Auction Bid-Snapper 200XP Riding Zero Turn Mower

- 1. Is there a buyer's premium or fee added to the bid price? No
- 2. If the bid amount for a unit is \$7500 and one is awarded to me what will the total price be? \$7500
- 3. Is there sales tax added to the final bid price? If yes, will you accept a resale tax id in order to remove the taxes? No
- 4. If no one meets the bid reserve for all of the mowers will there be another sale at a lower bid reserve? No, the mowers will not be sold below the reserve price of \$7500. I ask this because for 15% more you can buy a newer model with a 3-year warranty brand new and none of them brought that amount on the last bid. No decision has been made at this time regarding unsold mowers.
- 5. Is it too late to inquire about the mowers and the bidding? Our IFB states that all questions were due no later than April 26, 2023 @ 2:00 pm CST. Since this is a Reverse Auction Bid and most are not familiar with it, I am posting these questions and answers to everyone so that there is no confusion.
- 6. We just received the info on these and would like to ask if someone could provide year models, average hours, and condition of these mowers? The mowers are all 2021 model year. The travel time was under 30 minutes and/or 0.5 hours. The mowers were transferred from Messick to Farmville Warehouse. These are all brand new mowers. Pictures are a part of the bid package.

I downloaded the bid documents also...are all the documents included required to be filled out, such as Transmittal Letter, Insurance Coverage, Availability of Funds, etc. or are past the point of inquiring about this? Yes, please fill out the information and provide the insurance certificate / coverage.
