IFB # 05232023JKG COE Building Roof Replacement Re-Bid (#2)

- 1. Can either of you share why this project required a rebid? This project had to go out for a rebid due to funding change.
- 2. Is the expectation for this project to be a GC / Sub only project or for an architect to be a part of the team?

 GC/Sub only
- 3. Are there any existing drawings of the building? Specifically, where the reroof is required? Local Code Reviewers will require a structural analysis on how much water can pond on the roof and without existing drawings this would require core drilling / slab scanning to understand the construction.

 There are drawings that will be included and available via original link in addendum and Bid.
- **4.** Can the existing core sample information be provided? Core samples will be completed by the awarded contractor.
- 5. Any thoughts on not having overflow on this roof? Code would not require as it is a reroof, but if the parapet height is raised a condition would be made that makes the condition worse than it is today... and might trigger overflow. A roof typically is required to hold 3.5" of water and the current condition and potential height raising of the parapet could have over a foot tall parapet. Highly unlikely the original design (albeit concrete structure) was designed to hold 80 PSF live load on the roof. Overflow is not needed, as there are interior drains.
