

How to Respond to Law Enforcement

- 1. BE POLITE, RESPECTFUL and OBEY when stopped by a law enforcement officer.
- 2. DON'T RUN, even if you are afraid.
- 3. Don't under any circumstances get involved in a verbal argument with a law enforcement officer.
- 4. Stay calm and remain in control of yourself. Watch your words! Control your emotions! Watch your body language!
- 5. Keep your hands in plain sight and make sure the law enforcement officer can see them at all times.
- 6. Avoid all physical contact at all times with a law enforcement officer. Don't make any sudden moves.
- 7. Don't resist arrest, even if you believe you are innocent.
- 8. Know that anything you say or do can be used against you in a Court of Law.
- 9. If you feel your rights have been violated, you and your parents can file a formal complaint with the proper authorities.
